Additional Needs

SPACE

When playing Overwatch on PC, the standard is to move using the WASD keys while the mouse directs the “camera” and aim. With this, Overwatch players typically need more space on the desk for the mouse to move around rapidly without hitting nearby objects.

Sites should accommodate stations that have a minimum of 1.5 feet mouse space and limited obstructions for the student’s hand that holds their mouse. It’s likely most students will play with the mouse in their right hand, but it is helpful to check-in just in case.

PERIPHERALS

- ❑ Minimum six keyboards
- ❑ Minimum six computer mice
- ❑ Minimum six headphones with microphones

FLEXIBILITY FOR STUDENTS

Your students may have access to equipment that they are more familiar and comfortable with. It is important for general managers to include this possibility in communications with the IT personnel to ensure they are aware, necessary drivers are approved and installed, and to anticipate students needing to adjust settings.
